HISTORY BURSA ULUDAĞ UNIVERSITY

The foundations of Bursa Uludağ University (BUU) were laid with the establishment of the Bursa Faculty of Medicine under Istanbul University in 1970 and the Bursa Faculty of Economic and Social Sciences in 1974. Founded as "Bursa University" in 1975, it was renamed "Uludağ University" in 1982 and finally took its current name, "Bursa Uludağ University", in 2018.

Since its inception, the university has grown into one of Türkiye's leading higher education institutions, combining academic excellence with a commitment to innovation and community service. Guided by the principles of integrating education with research, fostering academic freedom, and providing students with a comprehensive, high-quality learning experience, the university has become a model for regional and national development.

Over the decades, BUU has continually evolved to meet the needs of a changing world. With its diverse academic staff, collaborative projects, and international partnerships, the university attracts students and researchers from Türkiye and across the globe. Today, it stands as a hub for scientific progress, cultural exchange, and professional growth, consistently ranking among the top universities in the country in various fields.

BURSA AND BUU: Where Heritage Meets Higher Education

Located in northwestern Türkiye, Bursa is the country's fourth-largest city and the second-largest in the Marmara Region. Renowned as the first capital of the Ottoman Empire, Bursa quickly rose as one of Anatolia's most influential centers of political, economic, and cultural life. During the first two centuries of Ottoman era, the city expanded far beyond its castle walls and became a major stop along the historic Silk Road, flourishing as a center of trade, especially in silk and textiles. This prosperity nurtured not only commerce but also a deep-rooted tradition of learning, marked by the construction of prominent medreses such as the Yeşil Medrese, commissioned by Çelebi Sultan Mehmed in the early 15th century.

Even after the capital moved to Edirne and later to Istanbul, Bursa retained its symbolic status as the Capital of Anatolia, a place where knowledge, faith, and craftsmanship thrived. That enduring spirit continues today, as Bursa has evolved into a modern industrial powerhouse, ranking second in national exports and offering a vibrant blend of culture, heritage, and economic vitality. With its lush green spaces, museums, historical landmarks, and dynamic urban life, Bursa provides an ideal setting for both living and learning.

BUU, located in this historically rich and economically active city, draws strength from its surroundings. The university embodies Bursa's legacy of scholarship and innovation—bridging past and future, heritage and progress, tradition and transformation. As a center of education and research, BUU is deeply integrated into the region's industrial base, cultural identity, and intercultural outlook, offering its students a unique environment in which to grow, explore, and lead.

BUU takes its name from Mount Uludağ, the towering natural symbol of the region that rises just beyond the city. Revered in antiquity as the Mysian Olympus, Uludağ is today a major ski resort and a national park, attracting visitors from across the country and beyond. This majestic mountain reflects the enduring beauty, strength, and aspiration that define both the city and the university—offering not only a scenic backdrop but also a reminder of the heights BUU encourages its students to reach.

Leading Academic Excellence Across Disciplines

The origins of BUU date back to the 1970s, when it was established under the auspices of Istanbul University, following Türkiye's tradition of established institutions guiding the development of new universities. Initially founded as the Bursa Medical Faculty, the university was created to meet the Southern Marmara Region's growing need for medical education and healthcare services. In 1982, it was renamed Bursa Uludağ University, reflecting its expanding academic scope and its geographical identity.

While medical education remains a cornerstone of the university—with our university hospital playing a central role in delivering advanced tertiary care to millions in the region—BUU has since grown into a multidisciplinary research university offering nationally competitive programs across a broad academic spectrum.

The Faculty of Theology is among the top three theology faculties in Türkiye. The Faculty of Engineering is deeply integrated with Bursa's industrial ecosystem, maintaining strong R&D collaboration with local factories and global companies, providing students with practical experience and industry-relevant training. Similarly, the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, home to one of Türkiye's most advanced Animal Hospitals, plays a vital role in animal health, food safety, and public health.

Several of BUU's programs—particularly in Theology, Law, Engineering, and Education—consistently rank among the top-choice programs in the ÖSYM (Student Selection and Placement Center) preference lists in Türkiye. These faculties not only attract high-achieving students from across the country but also produce graduates who are in high demand both nationally and internationally.

In addition to the Faculty of Medicine, BUU also provides health-related education through the Faculty of Health Sciences, the Faculty of Dentistry, and the Vocational School of Health Services. These units, located in close proximity, share clinical resources and benefit from interdisciplinary cooperation. Medical students gain early hands-on training in the Medical Simulation Center (USiM), equipped with the latest simulation technologies and designed to support skill-based medical education.

HOW TO GET TO BUU

Thanks to its strategic location and well-developed transportation network, BUU offers easy and convenient access for both domestic and international visitors. Situated in one of Türkiye's most industrially and culturally vibrant cities, BUU is ideally connected to major transport hubs, including Istanbul's airports and seaports. Whether traveling by bus, ferry, or airport shuttle, students, staff, and guests can reach our campus comfortably and efficiently. With direct links to both Istanbul New Airport (IST) and Sabiha Gökçen Airport (SAW), as well as regular ferry services across the Marmara Sea, BUU stands as a highly accessible destination.

ISTANBUL - BURSA (BY BUS) Istanbul New Airport (IST) IST to Bursa:

Take Istanbul Seyahat bus to Bursa at the -2nd level at IST. Tickets can be purchased in the kiosk next to the bus stop or online. The ride takes around 150 minutes.



Take "Istanbul Seyahat" bus from Bursa Bus Terminal.

Istanbul Sabiha Gokcen Airport (SAW) SAW to Bursa:

Take Burulaş BBBUS to Bursa across the exit at SAW. Tickets can be purchased in the kiosk next to the bus stop or online. The ride takes around 80 minutes.

Bursa to SAW:

Take "Burulaş BBBUS" from Bursa Bus Terminal.



Bursa Bus Terminal to Campus:

Take bus no 93 from Bursa Bus Terminal to BUU Campus. You need to buy tickets from the ticket machines. The bus to the campus takes approximately 40 minutes.





ISTANBUL - BURSA (BY FERRY):

There are two ferry companies with departures to Bursa: BUDO and İDO.



BUDO:

You can board the boats in Eminönü on the European side. There are no departures to/from the Anatolian side. The boats arrive at Mudanya port in Bursa. From Mudanya port, take bus no 2/U to BUU campus. Find the departures here.

IDO:

You can board the boats in Kadıköy on the Anatolian side and in Yenikapı or Kabataş on the European side. The boats arrive at Güzelyalı port in Bursa. From Güzelyalı port, take bus no 2/U to BUU campus. 2/U does not depart from the port directly and you will have to walk to the main road to get to the bus stop. Please ask for directions at the port.

INTERNATIONAL

BUU's approach to internationalization goes beyond mobility programs. It encompasses long-term academic partnerships, joint research projects, and the strengthening of global academic collaboration, through actively signed Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) with the higher education institutions around the world. As part of its research university identity, BUU strategically encourages research collaborations and joint publications. Internationally funded projects, such as Erasmus+, are actively carried out, alongside exchange and cooperation activities with eligible countries.

Erasmus+

Through Erasmus KA131 projects, students and staff can benefit from mobility opportunities within EU member states and partner countries. This includes study abroad, internships, and staff training or teaching assignments. The KA171 projects expand mobility beyond Europe, building academic partnerships with institutions in various regions around the world. BUU also takes part in KA2 projects, centralized Erasmus+ projects such as Jean Monnet and Erasmus Mundus, enhancing its role in European academic networks and joint graduate programs.

Orhun Exchange Program

BUU joined the Orhun Exchange Program in 2021 and has been actively participating since the 2022-2023 academic year. Each year, BUU hosts around 20 students and academic staff from Turkic Universities Union (TÜRKÜNİB) member universities, strengthening its role as a key academic hub in the Turkic world.

Secondos Exchange Program

This unique program, created through a special bilateral agreement with the University of Innsbruck (Austria), is exclusively designed for BUU and fully funded by Innsbruck. Each semester, it supports the exchange of masters and PhD students.

JLU Giessen Cooperation Program

BUU has maintained a strong academic partnership with Justus Liebig University Giessen in Hessen, Germany—one of its longest-standing international collaborations supporting student and staff mobility.

IAESTE Internship Program

Through IAESTE, BUU students gain professional, paid, course-related internships in 80+ countries, mainly in engineering, natural sciences, and applied arts.

Turkish Language Centre (ULUTÖMER)

ULUTÖMER offers Turkish as a foreign or second language to BUU's international students.

Centre for Research and Application on Turkic States and Related Communities ($T\ddot{\text{U}}\text{DAM}$)

TÜDAM promotes cooperation, research, and cultural exchange among Turkic states and related communities.

Erasmus Student Society

Founded in 2023, the Erasmus Student Society supports incoming and outgoing students with mentorship, orientation, cultural trips, and information sessions. As an ESN candidate branch, it is committed to intercultural understanding and student engagement.



CAMPUSES and STUDENT LIFE Görükle Campus

Görükle Campus, the central hub of BUU, offers a vibrant academic and social environment with expansive green areas, modern educational buildings, research centres, libraries, sports facilities, and social spaces. Located 18 km from Bursa city centre and directly accessible by metro, it combines easy transportation with a nature-friendly setting.

The campus hosts most faculties and administrative units, including Medicine, Economics, Engineering and Architecture, Veterinary Medicine, Agriculture, Education, Arts and Science, and the State Conservatory, as well as vocational schools, cultural centres, and the central library. Students benefit from on-campus accommodation, diverse sports opportunities, cultural and artistic activities, and nearly 170 student clubs organizing numerous events each year. Many of these clubs are founded by international students, encouraging integration and global connections.

The Prof. Dr. Fuat Sezgin Central Library offers over 200,000 printed books and access to more than 6 million digital resources. It is open 24/7 and it provides study spaces for 1,891 users, a digital portal, live chat support, interlibrary loans, and training services.

Other campuses enrich BUU's academic landscape: Fethiye-Faik Çelik Campus (Theology), Ali Osman Sönmez Campus (Foreign Languages and Social Sciences), Gemlik Sunğipek Campus (Law), Mudanya Campus (Fine Arts), and İnegöl Campus (Business and vocational programs).

BUU also maintains vocational schools in districts such as Mustafakemalpaşa, Karacabey, İznik, Yenişehir, Orhangazi, Harmancık, Büyükorhan, Keles, and Orhaneli. These campuses make higher education accessible across the province, fostering regional development and addressing local industry needs.



TECHNOPARK

Established in 2005 as Türkiye's 17th officially recognized Technology Development Zone, ULUTEK Technopark serves as a bridge between academia and industry. Located on the main campus, ULUTEK aims to strengthen national industrial competitiveness by supporting high-tech innovation, research, and entrepreneurship. By fostering collaboration between universities, research institutions, and the private sector, ULUTEK drives the development of new technologies, improves product and design quality, enhances production efficiency, and supports the commercialization of scientific knowledge. Today, ULUTEK is home to nearly 200 companies engaged in high value-added R&D and innovation projects, offering advanced infrastructure and opportunities for researchers, entrepreneurs, and international investors. With a strong emphasis on technology transfer and sustainable innovation, ULUTEK continues to be a catalyst for regional and national economic development.
