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## **ABOUT BURSA ULUDAĞ UNIVERSITY**

As an institution committed to raising contemporary, democratic, free-thinking young individuals with a strong sense of personal responsibility, guided by reason and science, who respect societal beliefs and values, embrace cultural and historical heritage, and possess an international vision, our university comprises 15 faculties, 3 schools, 15 vocational schools, 1 conservatory, 4 institutes, 25 application and research centers, 1 research center, and 5 departments affiliated with the Rectorate. The foundation of our university lies in the establishment of the Bursa Faculty of Medicine in 1970 under Istanbul University, and the Faculty of Economics and Social Sciences in 1974. Officially founded as "Bursa University" through Law No. 1873, published in the Official Gazette No. 15205 on April 11, 1975, the institution was renamed "Uludağ University" on July 20, 1982, under Statutory Decree No. 41 concerning the Organization of Higher Education Institutions. Later, with the enactment of Law No. 7141, published in the Official Gazette No. 30425 on May 18, 2018, the university was renamed "BURSA ULUDAG UNIVERSITY."



## ABOUT KELES VOCATIONAL SCHOOL

Keles Vocational School was established in 2002 and started providing education in the Department of Economic and Administrative Programs and the Department of Health Programs in the 2005-2006 Academic Year. New programs were added in 2006-2007 and the Organic Agriculture Program was opened in 2009-2010. However, some programs were closed due to insufficient demand. Some programs were offered as evening education in 2012-2013, but the Organic Agriculture Program was closed. Some programs were closed by the Council of Higher Education in 2017-2018. Approximately 1798 students have graduated to date. A total of 629 students are currently receiving education in 4 active programs. Keles Vocational School continues its education in accordance with the mission and vision of Bursa Uludağ University.

The Banking and Insurance Program aims to train qualified professionals for employment in the banking and insurance sectors, which play a vital role in the national financial system. The program offers a twoyear associate degree that combines theoretical knowledge with hands-on workplace training. It is designed to equip students with practical skills and sectoral awareness, preparing them for careers in financial institutions, insurance companies, and related organizations. The curriculum is structured to reflect current industry needs and trends, helping students build a strong foundation in financial services.
